Main Switchboard: IPEDS/CDS Front-End

The IPEDS/CDS front-end allows authorized users to access the back-end data and filter for subsets of students, based on any number of student attributes, such as school, department, major, first-time, full-time, first generation, residency, race, gender, age, etc. All calculations are performed within Microsoft's enterprise SQL Server. Calculations can be verified; clicking on any number instantly displays the students underlying the calculation. The "Source" data for all survey parts can easily be viewed.

New enhancement for 2014-2015 is automation of survey results by individual schools within the institution.

The IPEDS Graduation Rates survey provides the number of completers within 150% of normal time as well as transfers out, exclusions, and non-completers for a specified cohort, broken down by race and gender.

For report year 2015, the Fall 2011 cohort consists of 1,004 first-time, full-time, degree-seeking freshmen.

Total numbers of the cohort graduating within 150% of normal time were 24 (<1 year program and 163 (<4 year program); number still enrolled, 42; transfers out, 260; exclusions, 4; and not enrolled, 515 (rectangle).

NOTE: 150% of normal time for a 2-year program is 3 years.

On the **Main Form**, the user clicks the **Source** button to view the 339 students in the Fall 2011 cohort who entered in the School of Arts and Humanities.

Of the 339 students, 189 returned for Fall 2012; 50 graduated within 150 percent of normal time (i.e., within 3 years); 10 are currently enrolled; and 279 dropped out (bottom rectangle). Transfers-out totaled 114.

At the top of the pivot table are filter options. For example, the user can filter by school; department; major; 2nd-year retention; transfer out status; overall retention status; gender; race; first generation and/or recipient of Pell Grant, State Aid and/or Institutional Aid.
